Consider what you have already written in your in-class response paper “2.2 A Passage, The Method.” You have already begun the process of close reading a text, in this case a passage or short poem (e.g. Douglass, Alexie, Tan, Rosenwasser and Stephen, Stygall, the GIS 140 course policies). For this revision, start by typing up your response paper. Then develop what you have noticed and observed into 2-3 paragraphs of more formal analysis. Focus on one main idea, one main argument made by your passage and support your claim with evidence you gathered from close-reading the text. Be prepared to discuss the revisions you made in class.
