To facilitate your writing process, you may organize a peer review or workshop with one or more classmates to go over your cover letter, major paper, and short paper revisions. These peer reviews/workshops will count as extra participation credit and must be done by the Final Portfolio due date. Do not wait till the last minute to arrange a review or workshop. Type up your answers on a separate sheet of paper and attach the signed form to your responses to the following prompts:

I. Getting Ready: Before you meet with your peers, you should define a few things you would like to work on during your workshop. What do you want to accomplish? What are the main things you want to work on? Do you want help organizing your ideas? Working on grammar or language clarity? Do you need tips on paragraph development? II. Reflection: After your workshop, please describe the following in a 2 to 3 short paragraphs: What did you work on during your workshop (please be specific)? How did your workshop help you with your papers? Finally, what kinds of feedback and suggestions did you offer to your peers? What could you have done more effectively?

III. Assessment: After your workshop, please asses each of your peer reviewers or workshopers. What kind of feedback did they provide? What did you find most helpful? What did you find least helpful? How would you rate your workshop experience?
