- [6] While giving rather prompt feedback, the feedback is often hard to interpret and are often too ambiguous to be constructive.
- [8] Professor Chang is a very intelligent, humble individual. He speaks efficiently throughout the class and he explains all the course material in a way for us to understand since some of the texts are quite complicated to read. However, I dislike him correcting some of our answers to the materials. He is very one-minded to his own thoughts/opinions and doesn't allow students to freely express our comments without being corrected. I think he should take into consideration and value other students thoughts and opinions. Overall, he's a great professor and I look forward to taking more courses with him in the future.

Final open-ended comments:

- [1] Very laid back professor; provides tough but useful criticism on papers. Helped to strengthen my writing skills immensely.
- [3] Professor Chang's lectures and our class discussions were always interesting and thought provoking. Outside of class, I often
 found myself thinking about the topics and social issues we discussed.
- [5] Having the class act as an open discussion worked well sometimes. Other times you could easily gets lost because we weren't hearing much from the professor.
- [7] While the critical response papers come in handy, and are a good way of knowing if a student understands the material.. I think there should be an extra component to the grading process. Perhaps reports? Like a required amount of reports per semester (say 4 or 5) on something interesting that's going on in the media revolving around the "post-human" in addition to critical review. Perhaps make it an option or eliminate the review altogether? Just an idea.
